Supply List

“The Basics of Acrylic Painting”

- 16”x20” canvas, paper or board.
- Palette paper (12”x16” or larger) or Masterson’s Sta-Wet palette for mixing paint
- Watercolor or acrylic paper for color mixing exercise (9”x12” or larger)
- Acrylic paints (heavy body Golden, Liquitex or other brands are fine) – titanium white, ultramarine blue, pthalo blue, quinacridone red, cadmium red, naples yellow, cadmium yellow light, burnt sienna, raw sienna
You may use any other colors you already have
 - Others I use – light blue violet, light blue, brilliant purple, hookers green deep, pthalo green, cadmium orange
- Brushes – 1”flat angle, ½” flat angle or whatever you like to use
- Small sketch pad & pencil
- Plastic bucket for water
- Small spray bottle for misting paints
- Paper towels
- Wear old clothes or apron
