Supply List

“The Basics of Acrylic Painting”

- 16”x20” canvas, paper or board.
- Palette paper (12”x16” or larger) or Masterson’s Sta-Wet palette for mixing paint
- 2 pieces of watercolor or acrylic paper for color mixing and brush stroke exercise (9”x12” or larger)
- Acrylic paints (heavy body Golden, Liquitex or other brands are fine) – titanium white, black, ultramarine blue, pthalo blue, quinacridone red, cadmium red, cadmium yellow light or lemon. You may use any other colors you already have.
- Brushes – 1”, ½” and a small #2 brush (flat, angle or bright, whatever you like to use)
- Small sketch pad & pencil
- Plastic bucket for water
- Small spray bottle for misting paints
- Paper towels
- Wear old clothes or apron
