

## Jennifer Stone Supply List

Several supplies will be provided. Some will be free, some available for sale. I will also share my stencils and stamps to try. Try not to bring anything more than what is on the list as this workshop requires having as much workspace as possible.

Please bring the following:

1. Acrylic paint. The small bottles of inexpensive paint at Walmart or Hobby Lobby is fine for this project. Bring *several* bottles of various colors. Please *include* the basics, red, yellow and blue, in order to mix. Choose other colors that are your favorites. **Also include an 8 oz bottle of both black and white. These are important to bring!**
2. BOX. I will include a photo of the box that is ideal for this workshop. It is available at Michael's stores. If you do not find it, try to bring a comparable box. This box needs to be very sturdy, not flimsy or too large. The measurements for the box need to be larger than 13" x 13". If it's too large, it takes up too much space on your table. I do have a few to loan out but not enough for the entire class.
3. Six 4-inch foam rollers. (I will have these available for sale for \$2.50 each if you do not find them. I purchase mine at Menard's or you can go online. *DO NOT* buy long handled fuzzy rollers. I use the plain yellow foam rollers with a short handle)
4. One 3 to 4-inch flat foam brush
5. Roll of paper towels
6. Box of pop up Kleenex
7. Any stencils and stamps you have
8. 4-inch brayer
9. Empty plastic container for water i.e.: ice cream bucket size.
10. One inexpensive package of white gift tissue paper. Hallmark brand is good.
11. Black Sharpie marker, double tip ends
12. Notebook and pencil for note taking
13. Wear old clothes or bring an apron
14. Six quart sized Ziplock bags
15. Small spray bottle with a fine mist. (old hair spray, rinsed very well)
16. Fun Foam - peel and stick type. (Walmart)
17. Six quart sized Ziplock bags
18. Small Ziplock plastic bowls with lid
19. Scissors
20. Old toothbrush
21. Dress in layers for comfort.
22. Three plastic kitchen size garbage bags
23. Support board approximately 24" x 32"
24. Inexpensive plastic tablecloth or piece of plastic for drying extra papers on
25. Palette paper
