SUPPLY LIST

- 10” x 13” or larger drawing board or plexiglass
- Pad of 9 x 12” white Stonehenge paper
- One piece of Saral graphite transfer paper (minimum size 9” x 12”)
- Clear sheet protectors or a piece of Duralar
- Verithin Black pencil (2) #747
- Prismacolor Black pencils (2) #935
- Prismacolor White pencil #938
- Prismacolor Col-Erase Light Grey Pencil #20059 (optional)
- Colorless Blender
- Kneaded eraser or mounting putty
- White eraser (Papermate Tuff Stuff Eraser Stick works well), or a battery-operated eraser
- Tombow Mono Zero Eraser (optional)
- Soft brush to keep your work clean
- Q-Tips
- Battery Operated Pencil Sharpener
- 1 red permanent ink fine point marker
- 1 green permanent ink fine point marker
- Stylus
- Clear Plastic 6” Ruler (or any ruler you have on hand)
- Removable (Blue Plaid) Scotch Tape *or* FrogTape for delicate surfaces (yellow)
- Regular (Red Plaid) Scotch Tape
- Scissors
- Notebook or folder in which to keep your completed value studies and class handouts
- Pen & paper for taking notes (optional)
