## Supply List



### Watercolor Paper

*Please bring good paper, even for the scraps. It is the most important element of a successful painting!*

**Arches or Fabriano Artistico  
140 lb. cold press (22" x 30")**

*In total, you will need:*

- 3-4 full sheets for larger paintings
- Scraps (or the backs of old paintings) to practice on. About 10-12 pieces.

### Paint

*Please do not rush out and buy paints!*

*You will most likely have favorites or similar colors that will work.*

*Primary palette*

- Quinacridone Rose (Daniel Smith)
- Nickel or Lemon Yellow
- Phthalo blue green shade

*Darker value primary palette*

- Perelyne Maroon
- Quinacridone Gold
- Indanthrone Blue

*Neutrals*

- Burnt Sienna (Holbein)
- Payne's Gray

### Brushes

- Round brush with point, 8-10 size

*I love the Kingart Gold Max Round Size 10*

- 1/2" or 1/4" cat tongue or filbert

*My favorite is Joe Miller's 50/50*

- Flat 1" or 1.5" brush

*My new favorite is the Solo Flat*

### Other Stuff

- Gator Foam or a magnetic board that can fit a half-sheet
- I work on an easel that is tilted 45°*
- Palette with mixing areas (whatever you are comfortable with)
- Tacks/ Magnets
- Mechanical pencil or 2B
- Kneaded eraser
- Water container
- Paper towels & Tissues
- Mr. Clean Magic Eraser
- Scissors
- 3-ring binder (to hold handouts)
- Blow dryer
- Chargers for your ipad & extension cord

### Digital Reference

**If you have (or can borrow) a tablet, please bring it.** I use an iPad for my reference photo. During the workshop, I will give you tips on how to use a digital reference to your best advantage.

You will learn how to:

- Plan your painting for the best design
- Manipulate your reference image to better "see" what you paint
- Self-critique your works-in-progress
- Take a photo of your finished work for print and online use
