

Wanda Boyd Poinsettia Supply List

Watercolors

Bring your regular watercolor palette and any additional tubes of color you enjoy using. Try to include at least a warm and cool version of the three primary ones: red, yellow and blue.

Poinsettias come in everything from creamy white and blush to coral, pink and deep red, so bring any colors you'd like to experiment with. We'll try different color combinations before you choose the palette for your larger painting.

Brushes

1" flat wash brush

Medium round brushes — #10, #12 or #14

Small round brush — #2 or #4

Paper & Drawing Supplies

One half sheet of 140 lb. cold press watercolor paper, such as Arches or Fabriano. We'll use one quarter sheet for the large painting and the remaining paper for your three card paintings.

Support board, such as Gatorboard, large enough for a quarter sheet of watercolor paper

Masking tape

Pencil

Fine Point or Ultra Fine Point black Sharpie marker

Other Supplies

Paper towels

Water container

Fine spray mister

Apron to protect your clothes

Table covering to protect the table

Three cards and envelopes, black acrylic paint, drizzling stick, double-sided tape, reference images and tracing patterns will be provided.
