CLASS DESCRIPTION

Watercolor:Beyond the Ordinary

Watercolor/Gesso//Mixed Watermedia
All Levels

Description:



Combining watercolors and other watermedia brings a rich approach to both Realism and Abstraction. Using strong design elements and a playful attitude, students will build layers of color, line, and texture to create bold new paintings.

We will be working small so that we can learn several fun techniques. I will do several demonstrations involving both abstract and realistic subject matter.

Supply List:

Watercolor Paper, *6x12 Strathmore 400 spiral pad, One sheet Arches 300lb CP.

Watercolor Paints: We will be using fresh color, so bring the tubes to add fresh to your

palette, and do not squeeze them out ahead of time.

I like to use a lot of granulating colors including Prima-Tek colors from Daniel Smith, You will want to have several reds, yellows and blues to play with. Most professional quality watercolors can be fun to use.

Try to have at least one tube of the Daniel Smith Prima-Tek Hematite colors (Hematite, Hematite Burnt Scarlet or Hematite Violet)

Brushes: Assorted 1 1/2 to 1/2 flats (brights), a couple rounds, and a liner/rigger or two. Professional quality white and black gesso and Titanium buff fluid acrylic (Golden) Black Carbon Disc made by ArtGraf

Black Pigmented marker pens, like Pitt Drawing pens (I use M and F) or Micron, (05/08), etc.

Watercolor Pencils, Watercolor Crayons (If you have them)

Rubber stamps, either ones you made or ones you bought, or both.

*I will bring some of these with me and have them available for sale at close to my cost.
