- Strathmore Bristol Smooth Series 300 paper 9x12
- Drawing board or smooth surface with Bristol Smooth paper taped to it as cushion
- Pencil sharpener
- Drafting or soft brush to wipe away pencil dust
- Pink Pearl or White Pearl eraser or equivalent
- Tombow Mono Zero Eraser (looks like a mechanical pencil)
- Mounting putty or reusable adhesive putty (office supply stores)
- 000 round paintbrush
- White Stabilo “All” Marking Pencil #8052. “Aquarellable” printed on side of pencil (Dick Blick sells)
- Water – small container for painting
