

Abstract Painting Workshop

Supply List

Sponges - natural or small round brushes from Michaels or Hobby Lobby

Disposable gloves

Plastic **tablecloth** or **tarp** to cover tables - if not supplied by art center

An airtight paint storage **palette** to save paint

Freezer paper to use as paint palette on table

Masking tape

Rags

Viva paper towels

Spray water bottle and mist sprayer

Standing easel

Acrylic Gesso - 946 ml



canvases - 24"x 24", 24"x 30" or 30" x 30"



Liquitex or Golden modeling paste - 473 ml



Acrylic Varnish - 16 oz



Large containers to rinse brushes



Palette knives, scrapers, adhesive spreaders, hair picks, anything that can make marks in texture medium



Acrylic Paints

Please purchase professional artist acrylic paints. Stay away from "student" grade or "decorator" paints. Look for Golden, Liquitex, Matisse or other professional quality paints.

Suggested color palette:

Naples Yellow
Viridian Green Hue
Cadmium Yellow Light
Green Gold
Ultramarine Blue
Dioxazine Purple
Alizarin Crimson
Quinacridone Magenta or Brilliant Magenta
Pyrrrole Red Light
Indian Yellow Hue
Payne's Gray or Mars Black
Cobalt Turquoise
Transparent Yellow Iron Oxide
Turquoise or teal
Titanium Buff
Titanium White
Micaceous Iron Oxide - to paint sides for a finished look

Brushes

You will need 2 - 3 large brushes that are 1" - 3" wide

Creative Mark Primer 1" - 2"

Artist Loft # 12 - #18

Raphael Sepia - asst. sizes
(Jerrys Artarama)

1 - 3" or 4" foam brush for varnishing
