“MAKING COLLAGE AND A PAINTING” SUPPLY LIST

- *1 full sheet of #300 watercolor paper. any brand. (can be split in half) OR 2 12 X 12 canvases
- *1 large 22 x 30 approx. support board
- *Acrylic paint in a variety of colors. I use golden fluid acrylics.
- *black and white gesso or inexpensive paint 4 oz approximately. This is in addition of the acrylic paint already listed.
- *Include titanium white and carbon black
- *Assortment of acrylic brushes, include rounds and flats
- *a large OLD bath towel
- *Matte gel or matte medium any brand and an old flat brush to apply it
- *Pop up kleenex
- *Scissors
- *4 quart size zip lock bags
- *4 foam pro trim rollers (Menards)
- *Stamps and stencils you may have
- *Molding paste
- *An old credit/hotel key card
- *1-2 pkgs of white gift tissue (Like Hallmark brand)
- *4 kitchen size plastic garbage bags, not the stretch type
- Palette paper or freezer paper
- Masking tape
- *Water containers, include one that is larger, approx 6 in X 6 in or larger.
- *2-inch foam brush
- *3-inch brayer
- *Fine mister water bottle
- *Pencil
- *Acrylic inks if you have them
- Peel and stick fun foam (Walmart)
- *large piece of plastic for under table to dry papers.

Bring along any painting supplies you would normally use, better to have them!

I like to do some mark making with watercolor pencils and Caran d’Ache crayons so if you have anything else you’d like to use, this is the time to experiment!
