

KATHIE GEORGE GENERAL SUPPLY LIST for BATIK

Micron Pigma pen, size .05, black

Note: if any other pen is used it must be PERMANENT and WATERPROOF. Sharpies will NOT work.

Freezer paper

A large piece of dark construction paper, any color

Waxed paper

Newspapers

Hair dryer will be helpful

Paper towels

Tape

Paraffin - one block could be shared by two or three students.

BRUSHES: Bring your regular watercolor brushes, to include a 1 ½” flat brush. I have brushes that you may borrow to use in the wax.

If you need to buy a palette rather than bring your own paint, I can do that. The cost is \$4.50, and I would need to know if you want one **not less than 2 weeks in advance to give me time to order and prepare them.**

I prefer you purchase a sheet of rice paper from me so I'm sure you have the correct type. It is \$6.00 per sheet and will be enough to do both projects.

BATIK - SOUTHERN ELEGANCE

I use Winsor and Newton watercolors, but you can use whatever brand you already have. New Gamboge, Raw Sienna, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Cobalt Blue, Ultramarine (or French) Blue, Neutral Tint. Cobalt Green is optional.

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Winsor Violet, Cerulean Blue, Winsor Blue (red shade), Ultramarine Blue, Alizarin Crimson, Cadmium Orange, Raw Sienna, Cobalt Blue, Burnt Umber, Burnt Sienna.

FLAMINGO FRENZY - WATERCOLOR WITH A TWIST

Our surface is UART Grade 240 sanded pastel paper. I will purchase this for the class and cut to size so I can be sure everyone has the correct surface. I'm going to estimate \$9.50 each at the price it is at the moment.

BRUSHES: bring old brushes to use on sanded paper - one larger size brush (such as a one-inch flat) should do it. Used to apply background color only.

PALETTE for this piece: Bring Oranges and Reds of your choosing, as well as Black and perhaps Winsor Violet or Cobalt Blue. Quin Red, Cad Orange, Vermillion, Alizarin Crimson would all work well.

PASTEL PENCILS work best for the technique on this piece. Colored pencils will not work well. You do not have to go out and buy pencils. I have many small sets I will bring that they can borrow!

MISC: Stencils - random patterns work best, rather than floral shapes and such. If you purchased stencils from me last time I was there, those are perfect. However, others can be used - bring them!

White chalk pencil
Stainless steel pencil sharpener could be helpful
Backing board around 12 x 16"
