SUPPLY LIST

PAINTS

Bring your best watercolor paints-tube colors work best; min. 3 colors-blue, yellow, red or your favorite colors; no black or white

WATERCOLOR BRUSHES (suggested sizes)

- Several small to large rounds
- One 1" flat

OTHER SUPPLIES

- Small sharp scissors-for cutting details on heavy papers
- Black fine tip waterproof ink pens (i.e. Micron, Pitt)
- #2 Pencil
- Glue Stick
- Palette
- Paper Towels
- 2 Water Containers
- Apron
- Tombow dual brush pens (recommended, but optional) or water-soluble markers
- Any watercolor supplies you may have and want to play with...aqua pastels, watercolor pencils, Caran D'ache crayons, etc.)

Note:

We are experimenting and playing with supplies you may have no experience with. Do not spend a lot of money for supplies you do not have. I will have some supplies available for you to try and share.

The instructor will supply all papers and book-binding materials.
