### SUPPLY LIST FOR WATERCOLOR: LEARNING TO PLAY

Arches watercolor paper #140 cold press - at least 2 sheets 22 x 30

Watercolor brushes and palette with a large mixing area

Watercolor paints - no student grade paints such as Cotman or academy paints. Professional grade only

The main colors I use, but you don't need to purchase are:

Daniel smith: quinacridone gold, quinacridone burnt orange, quinacridone coral, undersea green and hansa yellow

Holbein: gamboge nova

American journey: indigo

Winsor-newton: cobalt blue, French ultramarine blue,

Winsor blue (green shade), Winsor green (blue shade), alizarin crimson permanent, scarlet lake, and permanent rose.

Bring your extra tubes of paint

Water containers, at least two

HB pencil

Eraser

Ruler

Fine mister

Mr clean Magic Eraser, original

Paper towel, (I prefer Viva signature)

Old bath towel

Notebook for taking notes

Matte medium (I prefer Golden)

2 boards, about 13" x 17" of some kind to tape down your papers

Small containers with lids (for example, Glad 4 oz. storage containers\_

Good tree references or other things you find interesting.
