"Turtle Time" Alcohol Inks on Yupo

Supply list

Kaleidoscope with Alcohol Inks !!!

- At least 9 colors of Ranger Adirondack Alcohol inks - sharing with a friend is fine if you both get 9 different colors.
- Blending Solution by Ranger Adirondack - can be shared
- Q Tips
- Cotton make up pads
- Several little plastic toothpicks with bristles - the kind with the little plastic lid
- Small, inexpensive brushes for the inks
- Miskit
- Miskit brush
- Paper towels
- Spray/mist bottle filled with 91% alcohol
- Thin, plastic stencils
- Watercolor supplies including water container
- Reference photos to paint from...keep the subject matter simple - fish, daisies, birds, trees, animal faces, flowers
- Transfer paper by Saral or Sally's, gray as well as white
- Tracing paper
- Scissors
- Several sheets, 4-6, of medium or heavy weight YUPO paper 20x26"
- Optional - anything that is non-porous, like plastic outlet covers, wall switch covers, glass, glazed white kitchen tile, can be used with these inks. Bring along what you have.
- Latex gloves
- Plastic to cover your work area as well as your wet painting storage area
- Apron
- Masking tape
- Ball point pen
- Rubber Stamps to experiment with
